Iraj Hashi is Professor of Economics and Director of the Centre for Research on Emerging Economies (CREE) at Staffordshire University Business School, Stoke on Trent, United Kingdom. In addition to his teaching duties at the University, he has been actively involved in research, teaching and consultancy in transition economies since 1992 and has worked with universities, research institutions and consultancy firms in Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Czech Republic, Kosovo, Macedonia, Poland, Romania and Russia on a range of projects dealing with challenges of transition in these countries. These projects have been funded by the European Commission, World Bank and other international agencies.

His current research is focused on a Framework VI project dealing with the impact of innovation on competitiveness of firms in accession countries and the innovation activities of small firms in a range of transition economies. His previous research focused on enterprise behaviour during transition, privatisation, corporate governance, SME development and entrepreneurship, and industrial competitiveness, the results of which have been published in books and journal articles.
