



Prof. Bryane Michael is primarily based at the University of Hong Kong and holds appointments at a number of universities world-wide. Bryane has taught law, economics and management for almost 15 years -- including significant stints at Oxford, Columbia, the World Bank and OECD. During that time, he has taught over 100 students by one-to-one tutorials from universities like Stanford, MIT, Harvard and others. He has also taught over 800 executives during executive education courses at Columbia, World Bank and in-house. Some industries and sectors for this in-house training include banking and insurance (Turkey), agribusiness (Ukraine), marketing (UK, India), transport-shipping (Ukraine, Bulgaria, Bosnia-Herzegovina), and others.
