

Marco Pagano, PhD, is a renowned academic and Professor at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Naples Frederico II. He is President at the Einaudi Institute for Economics and Finance (EIEF), Director at the Center for Studies in Economics and Finance (CSEF), and co-director

of the Research Programme in Financial Economics at the Center for Economic Policy Research.

He is consultant to the Italian Treasury on the reform of security markets and member of the Treasury's commission for privatizations. His work focusses primarily on financial economics, while other areas he has studied include banking, corporate finance, and macroeconomics. In 1997 he and Ailsa Roëll were jointly awarded the BACOB European Prize for Economics and Financial Research.

Journals that have published his works include the American Economic Review, the Review of Financial Studies, the European Economic Review, and the Journal of Finance.
