

Elena Jarocinska is CASE Research Fellow. She holds a PhD in economics from Universitat Pompeu Fabra, Barcelona. Her expertise includes regional economics, political economics, labour economics and economics of transition. She collaborated with the CASE Foundation since 1998. She has participated in a number of projects for the European Commission on the following topics: growth and employment, public investment, EU regional policy, economic convergence of EU regions, EU Single Market, innovation in the EU service sector. She was the CASE leader within DG REGIO project on the Impact of the Single Market on Cohesion: Implications for Cohesion Policy, Growth and Competiveness. In this project, the impact of the single market was investigated empirically in three distinct, but complementary ways: through simulations using general equilibrium models; econometric work on the effects of closer alignment of economic cycles, foreign direct investment and migration; and qualitative case studies of 20 regions. Dr. Jarocinska was also a CASE expert for an advisory mission to the Government of Georgia and Moldova. She published in *Economics of Transition*. Elena speaks fluently English, Polish and Spanish; her mother tongue is Russian.
